## MORWELL GOLF CLUB WOMEN'S OPEN CHALLENGE BOWL

## **CONDITIONS OF PLAY**

- 1. Entrance fees must be paid at the time of entry.
- 2. Entries and payment are to be made through the Secretary of the entrant's Club to the Ladies Secretary of Morwell Golf Club via email or mail as stipulated on the entry form. Entries and payments are to be received by the closing date.
- 3. The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and ancient Club of St Andrews, Scotland and the Local Rules of the Morwell Golf Club. If a dispute arises at any point, it shall be decided by the Match Committee in charge of the Competition whose decision will be final.
- 4. In every event, competitors will be drawn against each other for the day in such a manner as the Match Committee may arrange.
- 5. The Match Committee is to make all arrangements and to have full power to alter or make any variation in the Condition of the Program should they deem it desirable.
- 6. The Match Committee or such person as the Match Committee may authorise, may in the event of bad weather, shorten the contest or fix another day.
- 7. In the event of a tie in any of the events the winner will be decided on a count-back over holes 10-18. The Challenge Bowl will be decided combining the 3 Team Members' scores over the last 9, 6, 3 holes and then hole by hole from the 18th until a result is achieved. For individual events the winner will be decided by count-back over the last 9, 6, 3 holes and then hole by hole from the 18th until a result is achieved.
- 8. A player may obtain information by using a device that measures distance only. If during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect her play (e.g. Gradient, wind speed, temperature etc.) the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether such additional function is actually used.
